DESCRIPTION

Si TPO Primer is a primer used to promote adhesion with 100% Silicone Roof Coating to new and aged TPO roofing membranes. Si TPO Primer is manufactured from fast-evaporating solvents and adhesive resins. Primer has a blue color to allow applicator to better gauge application rates.

BASIC USES

MuleHide Si TPO Primer is recommended for priming new and aged TPO roofing membranes to improve adhesion of the finish coat.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

PREPARATION

- 1. Surface must be clean, completely dry and free from any foreign matter such as dirt, oils, grease or other debris that could adversely affect the primer to surface adhesion.
- 2. Recommended application temperature is 40°F and rising.
- 3. Do not apply to wet or visibly damp surfaces.

APPLICATION

- 1. Mix well prior to application.
- 2. Apply with a short nap roller or brush at the rate of 1-gallon per 300-400 sq. ft.
- 3. Application should be as thin as possible. Heavier application of the primer will reduce the effectiveness of the primer.
- 4. Allow Si TPO Primer to dry for one to two hours before top coating.
- 5. Si TPO Primer must be coated within 48 to 72 hours to prevent surface contamination prior to application of Silicone Roof Coating.
- Entire surface must be blue in color. Reapply to any areas that are not blue in color.
- Product dries by solvent evaporation eliminating concern for pot life limitations. Do not allow the primer to set with the lid off for long periods of time as the solvents will dissipate causing the primer to thicken and in turn be discarded.

Application instructions are basic guidelines only. Please read and understand the complete MuleHide specifications for our Silicone Roof Coatings prior to use.

STORAGE AND CLEANING
